## **Prichard Police need assistance in locating robbery suspect**

(PRICHARD, Ala. – Feb. 17, 2010) On Friday, February 12, 2010, at approximately 11:00 a.m., Prichard Police responded to a report of a robbery at Leaf and Petal Florist, located at 3324 St. Stephens Road. Upon officer's arrival, police were advised that a black male subject entered the business as if he was going to make a purchase, then pulled a handgun and demanded money from the cashier. The subject fled the scene after he was informed that there was no money in the register. The subject has been identified as 21-year-old Rodriguez Demetrius Toney of Mobile. Toney was wearing a white baseball cap, long sleeve white t-shirt, black jacket and blue jean pants at the time the robbery occurred.

Toney is currently out on bond in reference to two robberies that took place in November of 2009, also on St. Stephens Rd. Toney will be charged with Robbery 1<sup>st</sup> when apprehended in reference to the Feb. 12 incident.

Toney is considered armed and dangerous. He is also a possible suspect in three other robberies that occurred in the area of St. Stephens Rd. over the past weekend. His last known address is in Mobile, but he is also known to frequent the Saraland area. Anyone with information in reference to the whereabouts of Toney is encouraged to contact police at 452- 2211.
